- Since 2008, the IKI has been financing climate and biodiversity projects in developing, emerging, and transition countries.
- More than 1,000 projects with a current funding volume of almost €7.5 billion.
- Since 2022, the IKI has been implemented by three ministries.
- Project selection mainly in ideas competitions for various types of funding.
- IKI Strategy 2030 focusses funding on the 14 IKI priority countries.



Mitigation Action Facility

Leading the way in transformative climate action



- Vision: Accelerate decarbonisation to keep temperature rise to below 1.5°C.
- Priority sectors: energy, transport and industry.
- <u>History</u>: Evolved in 2023 after 10 years of implementation as the NAMA Facility
- <u>Value proposition</u>: An agile, high-impact and country-driven fund, that supports scalable, replicable sector-wide solutions in partner countries towards sustainable carbon-neutral pathways.
- **Funding:** Grant-based programme for technical support and climate finance to promote upscaling of innovative mitigation measures, selected in annual calls
- Funding partners: Germany, UK, Denmark, EU, CIFF

The IKI strategy: four funding areas with key fields of action for maximum impact

Around 50% of the funds flow into the area of GHG reduction; around 80% are earmarked for prioritized fields of action.




Spotlight on the IKI partner country Costa Rica

The IKI in Costa Rica

- Ongoing projects: 24, of which 4 bilateral and 20 regional/global
- Funding volume: €438m
- Partner: Ministry of Environment and Energy (MINAE), Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock (MAG)
- NDC support by IKI:
 - updating process
 - Implementation
- Lighthouse project: ACCIÓN Clima III, €10m; programme term from 05/2021 to 04/2026
