








#### What is Ecosystem-based Adaptation (EbA)?



#### Ecosystem-based Adaptation (EbA)

is

"the use of biodiversity and ecosystem services as part of an overall adaptation strategy to help people to adapt to the adverse effects of climate change" (CBD 2009)











## Implementing Approach

#### **Grant Distribution:**

- Direct grants via competitive calls
- Local, national, and regional projects

#### **EbA Facility Focus:**

- Support for Climate Adaptation
- Marine & coastal zones
- Insular Caribbean countries

#### **EbA Grants Support:**

- Ecosystem restoration & rehabilitation
- Reducing land-based stressors
- Reducing ecosystem pressures
- Minimizing physical damage
- Hybrid (gray-green) infrastructure
